Edna Esther Rose, loving mother and grandmother, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, Sept. 29, 2020.

Edna attended the Calvary Lutheran Church in Draper, Wisconsin where she

treasured her dear friends from the area. Many knew her as the one of the sweetest people, as she lived her life with kindness and graciousness, always. In her youth, Edna worked at the Kingsbury Ammunition Plant, and for 15 years she worked in the kitchen of Little Company of Mary in San Pierre, Indiana. Edna was also an employee of Colonial Inn in Winamac, now known as Kostas.

Edna is preceded in death by her brother Vernon Wilson and her sister, Wynona Hayes, lovingly known as “Uncle Sonny” and “Aunt Dub.”

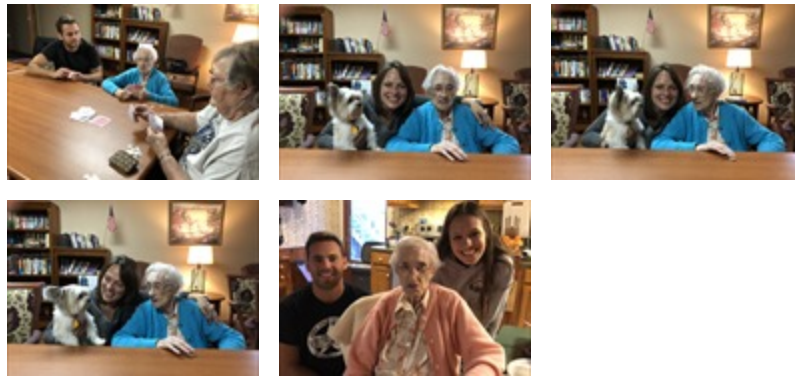

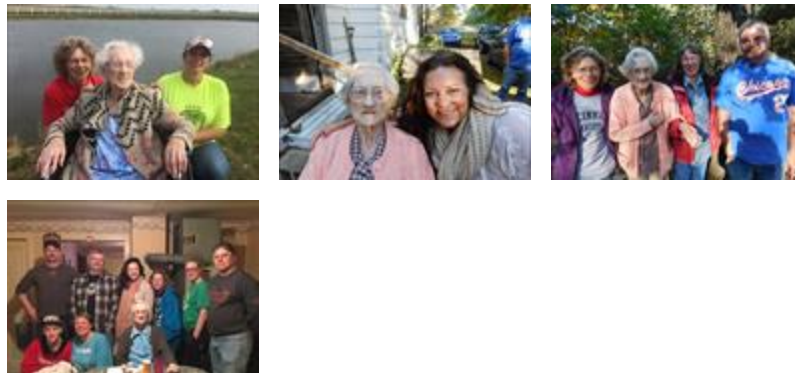
