Germaine L. Jones 96, of San Pierre passed away on April 29, 2021. She was born November 12, 1924 at the home of her parents John E. and Mathilda (Kruger) Will in Starke County on their county line farm.

She received her entire education at San Pierre and graduated from San Pierre High School in 1942. After graduation she worked at Champion Spark Plug in Detroit, Michigan during World War II.
