Irmgard Biruth Mueller Redweik, age 85 of RT 2, North Judson, Indiana passed away Tuesday, 16th of July.

Irmgard was born to Martha Mueller (Broksas) and Michael Mueller on 22, January, 1934 in Raigulan, Lithuania. Prior to establishing her home in North Judson, Indiana she lived in Germany with her family.

Irmgard was baptized as an infant on May 26, 1934 in Lithuania and renewed her baptismal vows in Backnang, Germany, 1950.

Irmgard was a retired Insurance Agent, Mother, Grand-mother and Great-Grandmother. Irmgard came to the United States in August of 1955, after living in Germany for 15 years coming from Lithuania in 1940. Seeking an adventure for a better life she and her brother Eduard boarded the "General W C Langfitt" and arrived to New York. She lived in Chicago where she worked as a secretary in a large insurance company. In 1962 she became a United States Citizen. She was a caring person and loved her family and her faith in the Lord. Prior to a stroke she was an active member of St. Peter Lutheran Church of North Judson.

She was married at St. Peters Lutheran Church, North Judson, Indiana, in a traditional German service to Ewald H. Redweik, also from Lithuania on 11 August 1956.
