John P Bochnicka Jr (known as “Boch” or “Face”), age 56, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday May 7, 2026 in a car accident. He was born on August 29, 1969 in Knox, IN to John Bochnicka and Sherry Sam's. John graduated from North Judson San Pierre High School in 1988 where he was a starting lineman on the Bluejays 1987 State Runner-Up team.

He was a man who loved working on cars and helping others whenever they needed it. He enjoyed being outdoors, going on adventures, and spending weekends searching yard sales for treasures he thought he might “possibly” need someday. His humor brought light to those around him, and many people will remember the laughter and smiles he shared so freely. Above all, he loved his children and family. He believed deeply in grace, second chances, and the power of God to change a life.

Though his journey was not without hardship, he was committed to becoming

the man God called him to be.
