Kathryn "Rosie" Amidei, of North Judson, left her Christian life here on earth for her eternal home in heaven on Sunday, January 19, 2025, at 7:37 AM after a brief illness. She passed away in her home at the age of 94. Rosie's life began in Missouri on May 7, 1930. She was born to Charles & Iva (Budd) Rigsby and grew up in Ora. Much of her childhood is unknown and she insisted to keep it that way.

On August 23, 1947, Rosie married Robert Widner and they were blessed with 3 children: Patricia, Sheri and William. Robert passed away July 10, 1954, due to an auto accident. It was tough raising 3 young children alone, but she always made the best of it. She learned the hard way that tragedy builds character and strength.

On December 28, 1957, she married Al Amidei. Al adopted the three older children and together they were blessed with a son, Donald.

North Judson became their home and the kids grew up together as a loving family. They were proud Bluejay fans and served the community in everything they were involved in. She enjoyed spending time with her family and friends. She was an excellent cook. Her signature meal was fried chicken, mashed potatoes and apple pie. She also made the best "dippy" eggs and fried taters. There's a sign on her wall "If Mom says no, ask Grandma" and she held that title proudly! Al passed away September 30, 2010. Rosie's strength never wavered.

Rosie was very well known in the community from her many years working at

Brantwood & Doug's Restaurant waitressing and making her famous potato soup. After the restaurant switched hands, she worked as a lunch lady at the NJSP Jr High until she was 90 years old. The staff, students and co-workers loved her and called her "Grandma". Her positivity could be heard and seen always whistling and humming, wiping tables or enjoying her daily walks. Most recently, Rosie attended the North Judson United Methodist Church. She enjoyed retirement, spending time with her special companion, Robert McKee. She attended the Pickin' Palace every Saturday night and breakfast club after church on Sundays. She had wonderful friends and family that took care of her. Most importantly, she was ready to be with the Lord. The last few weeks she would say, "I love you and I'll see you in Heaven." Rosie was a light in this dark world and she was loved and will be missed by so many.

Survivors include: a daughter Patricia (Edsel) Cox, Rotonda West, FL, a son Donald (Janet) Amidei, Francesville, IN.
