Olga Alma Matzat (95) formerly of Culver, passed away at 1:30 A.M. Sunday, June 18, 2023 at the River Bend Assisted Living Facility in Jeffersonville, Indiana.

Olga was born on February 26, 1928 in Lithuania to Karl and Emma (Jakubat) Redweik. Her family remained in Lithuania until 1941 when they escaped to Germany. They arrived in the United States on April 28, 1948.

Olga married Henry Matzat on July 27, 1951. They moved to Culver soon after and started their family. Two sons and three daughters (two deceased in infancy) were born into their union.

Olga retired from the Culver Military Academy after 48 years of service in the laundry/uniform department.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Henry, daughters Debbie and Connie, parents Karl and Emma Redweik, brothers Arthur, Edwin, Ewald, Robert; sister Meta; and half brothers Karl and Roland. She is survived by sons, Ken (Sue) Matzat of Pleasant Plains, Illinois, John Matzat of Jeffersonville, Indiana and Bonnie (Ed) Raffel of Kewanna, Indiana. She was proud grandmother of five and great grandmother of seven, as well as two great step granddaughters.
