Roger Dale "Dusty, Papa Moo" Scutchfield, age 66, passed away February 17, 2017, at his home in Knox, Indiana, surrounded by his wife and daughters. He was born on February 6, 1951, in LaPorte, Indiana to Arthur Scutchfield and Mary Coldiron Scutchfield.
